

**ORDINANCE NO. 323**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PITTMAN CENTER, TENNESSEE  
AMENDING THE 2022-2023 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET**

**WHEREAS,** the Town of Pittman Center adopted the fiscal year 2022-2023 budget by passage of Ordinance Number 318 on June 21, 2022; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to the Tennessee state constitution, Section 24 of Article II, no public money shall be expended except pursuant to appropriations made by law; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to the Municipal Budget Law of 1982, as found in the *Tennessee code Annotated*, section 6-56-209, the Mayor and Alderman have the authority to authorize the budget officer to transfer moneys from one appropriation to another within the same fund; and

**WHEREAS,** expenses and revenues for the General Fund will be greater than anticipated; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Pittman Center, Tennessee that changes be made to the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance Number 318 is hereby amended by increasing the Revenues budget by \$116,040, the Other Financing Use by \$348,369, and decreasing the General Government Department budget by \$25,825, the Police Department budget by \$18,500, the Street Department budget by \$7,082, the Sanitation Department budget by \$ 7,000, the Fund Balance by \$173,922.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and Alderman authorize the Budget Officer to make said changes in the accounting system.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, the public welfare requiring it.
