A motion was made by Steve McCarter and seconded by Billy McCarty to approve the Resolution. With all Ayes, the motion passed.


3. **Other Business:** City Administrator, Tammy Watts, shared that the current Human Resources Rules and Regulations state that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen may pay all or part of the cost (not exceeding 100.00 dollars) for an employee to belong to a fitness center in Sevier County. The town currently has (5) employees who live in Sevier County; (1) in Jefferson County; (1) in Grainger County; and (5) in Cocke County. There has been a recent inquiry about this benefit. A suggestion was made to check with the town's health insurance provider, BlueCross BlueShield of TN, to see if there are any incentives available to employees for fitness memberships. The employee handbook does need to be updated soon.

City Administrator Tammy Watts advised that a budget workshop is needed soon. Suggested dates for the workshop were Tuesday, March 24th, or Wednesday, March 25th.
